



READINGS FOR MAY

Happy Easter!

The traditional words we say in Church at Easter are, "Alleluia, Christ is risen", and the response is, "He is risen indeed. Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia!" It sounds bizarre taken out of context. Most things seem odd when taken out of context, or when you catch a phrase from someone else when you overhear a conversation. Alleluia is from the Hebrew language that means praise the Lord. In Church, we try not to say Alleluia during lent and avoid singing it in our songs. When you've gone without something for forty days, then it has an extra special meaning when you say/eat or do something again. I hope no one has been ill from overindulgence.

One of the hazards of driving around between the seven churches on Sunday mornings is sharing the road safely with the cars and the various pelotons. I wonder what they thought when they saw us standing in the street with Palm crosses as we started Holy Week with our walks to church. I wonder what the drivers and passengers thought when they passed us on Good Friday as we walked from Copthill carrying a cross to Uffington? In a small way, I hope it helps to remind the community that your Church is there for all of us when we need it.

As we continue to serve the community, we will need others to help. Nearly all of the Churches have had their annual meetings, and we've elected some new Church Wardens. New people have offered to help by being on our Church Councils (they're called PCCs if you overhear people talking!). Not all volunteers need to be on committees. We currently need help with:

- Magazine Production
- Magazine Advertising Sales
- Design of Banners and Signs

If you can help as a one-off, or regularly, then please let me know. To help out, you don't need to be committed to coming to Church; wanting to help your community is enough.

Easter lasts for 50 days - it's the Church's longest season of celebration. During this season I'll be meeting more of you and trying to understand what goes on in the villages. I'll be able to serve you all the better if you share your thoughts, your hopes and your fears with me. I now know that you tend to prefer Leonard Cohen to Stormzy. But I wonder if more would come to Church if you knew that our services covered the spectrum of being very traditional, and sometimes too modern! I need to find ways to invite you more efficiently and to tell you what's going on and to encourage you to invite others along.
