

### Happy New Year!

I hope you've all enjoyed your Christmas, and that you're all set for the New Year. For many people at the moment, though, the New Year is bringing more fear and worry than excitement and anticipation, with anxiety over jobs and housing and debts.

Representing the church, it can be very difficult to comment on something like the economic situation. It's a case of damned if you do, and damned if you don't. If we ignore the subject, then we're just not living in the real world – but if we do weigh in, we're talking about things we should keep our nose out of, because finance is one of many topics some people think the church shouldn't have an opinion on. Yet churchpeople have jobs and homes and incomes – and debts and problems, too. We are just as affected by recession as anyone else – and so, of course, it's something we too think and talk about.

That doesn't mean I've got a solution, of course – I'm not an economist, and high finance is a mystery to me. But this whole situation reminds me that the church has always taught about good stewardship: that we have this world in trust, and it's our job to look after it, and hand it on to the next generation in good condition.

That's a notion that's very familiar to farmers, of course, looking after the land, using it well to provide food and a living now, but also looking at what they'll be leaving to their successors, trying to make sure that they pass on something in good heart. That means not taking the short term profit at the expense of the long-term viability; it means using wisely, not exploiting. It's a way of life that we perhaps need to rediscover, based on sustainability, not greed.

With such major worries to cope with, it can be very easy to feel we've no energy left to worry about anything else. But good stewardship isn't just something to think about when we're doing well, in the same way that loving our neighbours, caring for other people, isn't only for when we have no problems of our own. We need to think about the long term, about the effect we have on the world around us – and perhaps, if we think about the long term, it might help us cope with the worry of the short term, and hope that the problems we see around us now will pass.

### WILDLIFE GARDENING IN JANUARY

As the winds blow in from the east and north-east, they not only bring in the snow from Siberia and northern Europe, but migrating birds escaping the harsh winter there. The birds are seeking the comparatively milder climate of our country, as it lies in the ameliorating Gulf Stream.

During the autumn months, we have seen increasingly large flocks of redwing and fieldfare feasting on the berries in the hedgerows. Not just these, but other members of the thrush family including large numbers of Blackbirds and Mistle Thrushes come from the continent to the UK.

Fieldfares are large thrushes with grey heads and rumps with rufous-coloured backs. They have a harsh chattering "cha-cha-chack" call. These birds, like Redwings, arrive in October and depart in April for their breeding areas in northern Europe. Redwings are smaller than Fieldfares and so called because of the bright red colouring underneath their wings.

These visitors tend to be wary of people preferring to feed in large flocks in the hedgerows and open fields, but as the weather becomes severe they will come into gardens both for shelter and food. Berries on hawthorn, pyracantha and snowberry are eagerly sought, and any remaining fallen apples or apples put out deliberately for the birds (together with other bird food) should also encourage these visitors into our gardens.

Thrushes are not the only birds to arrive here in winter from the continent. Two other colourful visitors are Waxwings and Bramblings. Waxwings (about the size of Starlings) feed on Hawthorn and Cotoneaster in gardens and parks. They are distinctive with russet and grey plumage, black and yellow in the wings and tail, and with the males having an orange crest. These and Bramblings (like chaffinches but with orange, white, black and grey plumage) have already been seen in local gardens.

So the cold weather can bring snow but also colourful continental visitors!



### **UFFINGTON**

Uffington Parish Council. Report from Parish Council Meeting held on Wednesday, 28<sup>th</sup> November, 2012 at 8pm in the Village Hall. After much discussion regarding Item 5 under Correspondence of the previous Parish Council Minutes dated 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2012 it was decided to alter this paragraph to read "Refer this matter to Minutes of 25<sup>th</sup> July. 2012. Play Area – The Questionnaire is now in the process of being delivered to all the key stakeholders in the Village for their comments. The Wind Turbine planning application has now been withdrawn. The One Way System seems to be working apart from the queues during the early morning school runs and people going to work. County Councillor M. Trollope-Bellew reported that the plans for the Tallington Crossing are to be out by March 2014 or the funding will disappear. He also reported that the Chestnut -Tree on the Essendine Road junction should be taken down for safety reasons. There have been complaints regarding lorries running over the verge at the entrance to Manners Close, LCC Highways have been informed. LCC Highways also to be informed regarding the following:

- The flooding on at Newstead and on Newstead Corner
- Pot Holes in and around the village
- Newstead Lane and Essendine Road verge erosion




