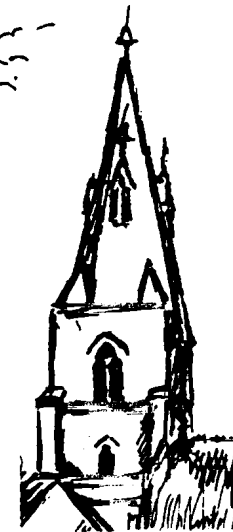

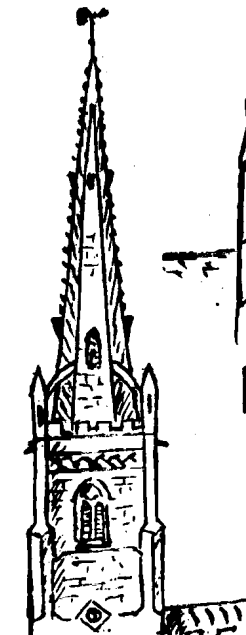

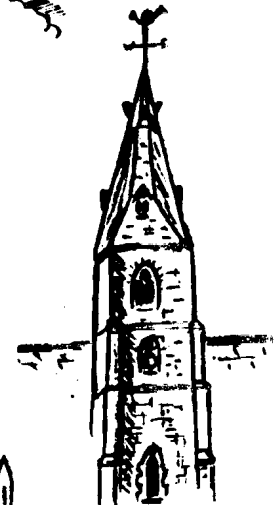

# The Last Supper

**7 pm, Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April, in Braceborough Village Hall  
Tickets £2, family ticket £5, to cover a light supper**

This year we're going to share a meal and service following the pattern of the early Christian church, the first followers of Christ.

When Jesus met with his friends in the first Holy Week they shared a meal and fellowship, eating and chatting, before the meal became special and significant in a new way, as Jesus blessed the bread and the wine and gave it to his disciples. We will do the same thing, sitting at table together and sharing a simple meal of bread, cheese and fruit and a glass of wine before hearing the story of that Last Supper and moving on to a celebration of communion, still seated at table.

We will also re-enact some of the other events of that evening. Just as Jesus washed the feet of his disciples (shocking them, because they thought he was too important to do that for them), so the tradition is that the most senior clergy wash the feet of at least some of those present at the service - in a cathedral, it would be the bishop or the dean. Here it will be the Rector (NB having your feet washed is not compulsory - volunteers only!). And at the end of the evening, as Jesus and the disciples went to the Garden of Gethsemane to pray, we move on to the church, where traditional psalms will be read and the altar stripped, ready for the bleakness of Good Friday.

If you'd like to find out more about the Last Supper, and how communion as we know it started, why not come along and find out. This celebration is open to everyone, whether they've been confirmed or not, and is a family occasion where children are welcome (it will go on until at least 8.30pm, but families can opt out of the time in church). Tickets are available from the churchwardens or the Rector - please do book, so that we know how many we are catering for. Also, please note that this is a *light* supper – you'll need to eat beforehand.

*Dear All*

This year April moves us straight into Holy Week and Easter, with Palm Sunday on the 1<sup>st</sup> - why not come along for the blessing of the palms and the reading of the Passion story at the services that day, and take a palm cross home with you.

There's plenty going on in Holy Week across the group, too, with at least one service every day, so that you can follow the story right the way through the week and walk the way of the cross. On Monday and Tuesday evenings there will be communion services at 7.30pm - Monday at Greatford, Tuesday at Uffington - and on Wednesday there will be a communion service at 10am at West Deeping. On Thursday evening there will be a commemoration of the Last Supper starting in Braceborough village hall and moving on to the church - see the separate notice for details. This is a great opportunity for fellowship as well as a chance to learn about the first Holy Week, and well worth coming to; families are welcome, and it doesn't matter whether you've been confirmed.

Good Friday is going to follow the same pattern as the last few years. The church services will take place as usual, in West Deeping at 11am and Uffington at 2pm, and once again some of us will be walking (mostly on footpaths, not the road) from one church to the other, with a pause in Tallington on the way. You can come to just the services, just the walk, or join us for part of the route - check the posters at each church for exact timings, and let's hope that the weather stays fine... There'll also be our usual evening service at Barholm at 7pm.

Easter Day will be full of services - not only will there be a communion service in each church, as usual, but we're going to start the day with an Easter Vigil and the lighting of the new fire, otherwise known as a dawn service. I'm not an early riser by nature, but I'll be at Wilsthorpe at 5.45am (late this year!) to celebrate the discovery made at break of day, when the women went to the tomb and found that Christ had risen. As a sign of the light of the risen Christ coming into the world, we'll light first one and then another six Easter candles, and take them on to the parishes for the communion services later in the day. Why not stagger out of bed and really know you're celebrating Easter - and don't forget to bring bells/jangling keys/anything else that makes a joyful noise, for use during the service.

Please come and join us on Easter Day and during the preparation for it, as we experience the richness of the Christian story and celebrate the new life God gives us in Christ.

**Uffington Parish Council.** Report from Parish Council Meeting held on Wednesday, 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2012 in the Village Hall. The transfer of the Play Area at rear of Lindsey Road from Jelsons to the Parish Council is in the final stages of completion. Once this piece of land belongs to the Parish Council a Committee will be set up to oversee the running of it. The proposed sub-station at end of Bertie Lane/Lindsey Road footpath is causing concern not only for the Parish Council but for nearby residents. At the moment we are unable to ascertain any real information regarding this but as soon as we can a meeting will be called for concerned residents to air the views. County Councillor Martin Trollope-Bellew informed the meeting that the one-way system work should commence by the end of March beginning of April, 2012. Various planning applications were discussed with no objections but there was very great concern regarding one which was proposing to install 10 metre high floodlighting pylons on the playing field at Copthill School. It was felt that this would cause a distractive presence to road users on this already dangerous right angled bend and confusion to those travelling to Barnack. The Parish Council objections and concerns were sent to SKDC Planning Department. The Clerk was also asked to contact our PCSO Michelle Laughton requesting her to speak to the building contractors at 1 Main Road asking them to clean up the mud off the footpath and road which could be potentially dangerous. County Councillor M. Trollope-Bellew reported that not all the salt LCC had stockpiled for this winter had been used as it have been an average winter. Date of next meeting which is the Annual Parish Meeting and the AGM of the Parish Council is on 9<sup>th</sup> May at 7.30pm.

We start the month in red, with no flowers, staying red for the beginning of Holy Week. Maundy Thursday is white, on Good Friday there are no frontals or hangings at all, and Easter of course is white and gold with flowers galore. Usually, the readings for communion services are the NT and Gospel, and for Morning or Evening Prayer the Psalm, OT and NT, but in Eastertide the reading from Acts is compulsory. So, at all services from Easter onwards we will read Acts and the Gospel, plus the psalm at non-communion services. Incidentally - yes, I can count - Easter Day is reckoned as the first Sunday of Easter, and the numbering follows on from there!

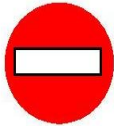
## COPHILL COMMUNITY CHOIR

## WILDLIFE GARDENING IN APRIL

A pond can add a whole extra dimension of interest to a garden. Along with being an attractive feature in its own right, if the pond is designed with wildlife in mind it can attract a host of interesting animals, from frogs to dragonflies. Frogs, toads and newts also bring the bonus that they love to eat garden pests such as slugs and snails!

It is good if wildlife ponds have gently sloping sides so that pond animals (e.g. amphibians), as well as hedgehogs, can easily get in and out, and birds can use it for drinking and bathing. It is helpful if there are ledges where marginal water plants can be planted in suitable containers. Some stones carefully positioned here are used by animals to hide under or to crawl onto them out of the water. A couple of edging paving slabs or flagstones can provide a standing area for pond-dipping and admiring the life in the pond without making a slippery, bare edge.

If you don't already have a pond, there are a number of basic considerations, like the safety for everyone using the garden, and also where to site the pond. This might be a low-lying area, where water naturally drains, or a quiet corner. Some partial shading is valuable, but you do not want your pond to receive insufficient light otherwise water plants will not be able to grow. If the pond is directly underneath a tree, it will be very shaded and all the leaves the tree will shed in autumn will cause lots of extra maintenance work.

It is hard graft digging a hole for your pond, so get ready to shed some pounds! Also think in advance where to put the material you remove – perhaps using it to re-landscape other parts of your garden. A key part of digging the hole is to ensure the edges are level and a spirit level is useful. If not level, the water may run out at one end!

Various materials can be used to line the pond. Butyl rubber is the most expensive, but considered the best and should last the longest. Long-life PVC lining can be a cheaper option but does not 'give' if the soil in the hole settles a bit later on. Both butyl rubber and PVC are sold in sheets which can be laid over and moulded to fit the shape of the hole you have dug. Look on the internet for calculations to determine how much flexible liner is needed to cover the hole you have made. The other alternative is to purchase a pre-shaped or 'shell' liner of fibreglass but with this type it is important the hole exactly matches the shape of the 'shell'.

Remove stones and any large roots from the hole as these could puncture the pond liner. Then spread a 5cm layer of builders' sand across the hole and layers of newspaper on the sloping sides, or old carpet can be used instead. Some liner 'deals' recently seen on the internet include underlay. Carefully lower the liner into place, and when completed make sure the edges are covered with soil. Some animals, such as pond skaters, will move in almost immediately but most will arrive as you plant pond plants in the water and around the edges. Pond plants are needed very quickly to combat blanket weed and provide good habitat for wildlife. For a wildlife pond, please don't put in fish as these will eat all the wildlife and will contribute to problems with blanket weed.

**Apologies** – We did not make an 'appearance' in the March edition.

**Update on repair work at St. Margaret's.** During the late autumn and January of this year significant repair works have been undertaken on the church building. John Lucas, Peterborough Ltd. has repaired the fallen ceiling in the porch, replaced stonework on 3 corners of the nave roof and re-pointed significant areas of the external stonework, including replacing a number of badly eroded stones. MDS Stained Glass has repaired 12 individual pieces of glass – both stained and clear in various windows within the church. 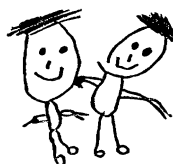
