## From the Rector:

I hope you had a blessed Christmas and Epiphany. Uffington School has been marked with a great chalk blessing above the door leading into school from the playground to remind us that Christ blesses our homes, and the places where we learn and work. We just need to invite him! That's a difficult thing for some of us to do, and it may be very hard for us to encourage others to let Christ into their lives.

Holman Hunt painted a picture called, "The Light of the World", you may have seen one of the originals in Oxford, Manchester or St Paul's Cathedral London. It was so popular that Holman was asked to make copies. The important point about this image is Christ waits outside the door to come in. I think we're being asked to imagine that he is there waiting at our door, but as he waits expectantly he waits until we invite him in. He's not able to let himself in because there's no handle on the outside.

Last month I wrote about loving your neighbour and visiting them. I mentioned that I had noticed, perhaps because of past problems, or through pride we sometimes don't accept the offers when made, or open the door. But that doesn't mean we should give up. Sometimes our neighbours really want our help, they are desperate for a conversation and it's all too easy to ignore them. We may have heard about someone suffering dementia and don't know what to say to them or their partner or carer. Having met with a couple recently I can say that in their circumstances they would love more conversations in the street and visits to their home. We can only work out what's needed if we ask. We just need to start with a, "Hello". It's the same for those bereaved, or for any of us whose circumstances have changed. It's all too easy to ignore those around us because the metaphorical door is shut. And using the image that Holman Hunt painted, not realising that we have to invite the person in, and they have to have made the effort to call in the first place. Please don't give up spreading community spirit, by saying hello more often, stopping for a chat and knocking on the doors more often; why not arrange to meet in one of our wonderful pubs, there are five to choose from, for a drink and a chat and meet even more people.

One of the benefits for U3A was explained to me recently. The U3A (University of the third age) is as much about meeting others and therefore preventing loneliness now and in the future as friendship groups are built up. Please ask me for more details or seek out Michael Crowe who has all of the information about U3A at his fingertips.

As I continue to discover all of the wonderful things that are happening across our seven parishes I wonder if I could draw your attention to a service in Wilsthorpe on the 3rd March at 10:30 (Holy Communion). Archdeacon Justine is coming to visit us and it's a great opportunity to hear her speak. She's coming as part of a formal visitation that will help us grow church in the benefice and she's also the author of the study course that I will be running in Lent.

I hope I continue to discover more about the seven villages and that I get to see more of you especially as we prepare for Lent and Easter. May you find more welcome neighbours at your door and in the streets and lanes.

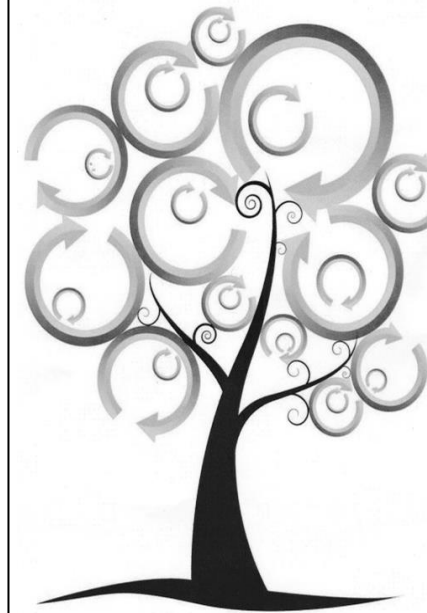

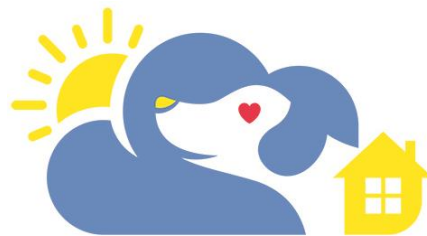
