

Happy Christmas! I hope the season of Advent and Christmas so far has been a blessing to you. I know that it isn't for everyone. The celebrations of it can get us down, because it's difficult to see your blessings let alone count them. If you think someone, one of your neighbours, may be in need then please help them - perhaps call in, or if you don't feel able let me know. I hope I can find a way to help. Sometimes I need a prompt.

As I spend more time with the School Children in the Uffington Village school (the benefice's Church of England School) I can already see how they are growing - from watching the foundation stage at the weekly Open The Book sessions where the children get to hear the classic bible stories from a great bunch of volunteers (I think the grown-ups might enjoy it more than the children!) To the year 6s asking really informed questions. The moral teaching in the bible, with correct interpretation, will help all of the children grow to be the individuals we need them to be!

We talk about the bible being simplified into, "worship God and love your neighbour". In time I hope we can find ways to love our neighbours and to learn from things when they don't go to plan. A reason we might use for not visiting our neighbour is that previously we didn't get on, or they like to keep themselves to themselves. The only way we'll change them, or discover something different about them is when we change ourselves. I wonder what would happen if we all called on people, our neighbours, more often?

One thing I'd like to happen is that more people are able to see God as part of their life. An important part where they start to understand where things fit together - they can see the freedom that it gives, rather than as a burden or something long ago dismissed. One of the things I'd like to do is to lead services that you want to come to. Ones that help you with all aspects of your life. If you think this means we need to change what we do then please share your ideas. If what we do now is right then please come along, or invite your neighbours to come. It could be fun as we grow together.

I continue to pray for all of you, and we can make our communities stronger than they already are. And where there are things that are wrong we can sort them out together.


