

BRACEBOROUGH & WILSTHORPE PARISH COUNCIL

Cllr Dave Kentish welcomed 8 parishioners to the Council meeting at Wilsthorpe where a number of new residents introduced themselves. The Chairman informed the meeting that the proposed presentation of a pre-application consultation of 8 new properties along Manthorpe Road, Wilsthorpe had been withdrawn at the landowner's request from SKDC. The Clerk reported that she had obtained 6 new passive 30mph speed signs as replacements, but was still waiting to hear about the hand held speed gun for parishes from the Road Safety Partnership. It was agreed that a new rubbish bin for Braceborough should be sited by the BT Kiosk with the one for Wilsthorpe at the entrance to footpath 6. The meeting was informed that the proposed erection of a property at land east of the Old Rectory, had been withdrawn, Councillors made no representation regarding the Manor Farmhouse, both properties at Braceborough. The erection of a single storey link extension and first floor extension at Glenside, Wilsthorpe had been approved. It was agreed that the Council would arrange for junctions within the parish to be stimmed by a contractor. D.Cllr Barry Dobson and C.Cllr Rosemary Trollope-Bellew gave updates on both authorities. SKDC environment team is among the best in the UK for food hygiene standards as it has been placed 5th out of 389 local authorities. The Council will be providing 36 new parking spaces in Stamford to help with the high demand in this popular Market Town. The individual spaces will remain the same size with no impact on disable parking. 'Lottery SK', which is due to be launched in the autumn, aims to raise thousands of pounds for lots of local good causes and charities within the District. DEEPINGS WEST & RURAL DIVISION

More than three tonnes of waste was collected in the first two days of Lincolnshire County Council and South Kesteven District Councils food waste recycling trial. The scheme, which will last a year, collects food waste from 4,700 households across one given route in the district. A new purpose built building to house 24 Fire & Rescue staff, 38 Ambulance Clinicians and the County's Search & Rescue Team has been opened at Sleaford. This will provide a quicker response and working relationship with the various services. The Council maintains about 12,000 miles of grass verges which are only cut twice a year, the authority is happy for residents to cut grass outside their own property but to act responsibly. A meeting was held with the highways manager at Thurlby with the main conversation being slow repair of potholes/roadside breakup. SOMES TRUST STUDENT BURSARY SCHEME 2018

One of the main purposes of the Somes Trust is to promote the education of young people who are either resident in Uffington or who have attended Uffington School. The Trustees are concerned that, with grants being replaced by loans and contributions being required for tuition fees, life has become much tougher for students embarking on higher education. The Trustees want to help ensure that the young people of Uffington get as much as possible from their higher education and have therefore decided to again run a Bursary Scheme for young people under the age of 23 embarking on higher education for the first time. The Bursaries will be discretionary one-off payments and are intended to help cover some of the initial costs of further education such as textbooks, equipment and deposits on accommodation. The size of these awards will depend on the number of successful applicants and the merits of the individual cases, but will not be less than £100.

Applications are invited from people under the age of 23 who are entering higher education for the first time in 2018. To be eligible you must either be resident in the Parish of Uffington, or must have attended Uffington C of E Controlled Primary School. If you want to apply please write to:- The Trustees of the Somes Trust, c/o The Homestead, Greatford Road, Uffington. In your application please state which course you will be doing, which educational establishment you will be attending and what date you start. Please also say if your course is full or part time and whether or not you will be living away from home. The Trustees will need to have details of why the money is needed and what you intend to spend it on. Applications must be received before September 1st 2018. Successful candidates will be notified before 1st October 2018.


