



### Dear Friends

As we move in to December, the Church's season of Advent very much encourages us to look forward to Christmas – though perhaps not in quite the same way as the commercial world has been urging us in recent weeks. Some of the church's traditions of Advent have spilled over into the wider world: Advent calendars no longer depict religious images and subjects but now very often focus on chocolate treats; Advent candles probably now generally count down the days of December rather than the Sundays of the Advent season – though the candles which are lit in our churches on the four Sundays of Advent do help us to focus on the way that various people of old were given an insight into God's promise to send his Son.

During Advent this year, as well as many of our regular services, our various churches will have a number of special events — at which folk from any of our parishes (and beyond) will be very welcome:

- On 3 December at 6pm, Barholm Church will have an Advent Carol service when
  in the special atmosphere of St Martin's Church we can savour the carols and bible
  readings recalling God's promises about the earthly birth of His Son.
- On 10 December, there is a Christingle Service at 3pm in Greatford Church when
  the young in heart can make their Christingles and enjoy the wonderful imagery of
  Christ the light of the world coming to the (orange shaped!) world, sharing the
  fruits of the earth in their seasons, and shedding his blood (symbolised by the red
  ribbon). And then at 6pm there is a carol service in Tallington Church.
- On 17 December, West Deeping Church will hold a carol and crib service designed for all ages, and at 6pm there will be the traditional service of nine lessons and carols for all the parishes in Uffington Church – there's still just time for singers to join the choir at the rehearsal in Copthill School on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> December.
- On 24 December we start with a (short) Communion service at 9am in Greatford Church focussing on the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Advent theme of the Virgin Mary looking forward to Christ's birth; while at 10:30am the Uffington Crib Service, designed for all ages, will think of Jesus' birth.

Then during the afternoon of 24 December we move into full Christmas mode, with carol services at Wilsthope (3pm), Braceborough (6pm), and Greatford (6pm). And at 11:30pm, both Tallington and West Deeping churches celebrate the First Communion of Christmas — with our other five parishes having Communion services on Christmas Morning: Barholm, Braceborough and Greatford at 9am; Uffington and Wilsthorpe at 10:30.

The Christmas season can be a busy and demanding time, but we hope that you (and your families and visitors) will be able to find a time and type of service when you can join us to celebrate anew God's concern for humanity – demonstrated in the birth of the Lord Jesus Christ to enable him to show God's love and purity throughout the ages to all people.






