



#### WILDLIFE & GARDENING IN MARCH

A perennial is an herbaceous plant that lives for more than two years (as opposed to shorter lived annuals and biennials). Some perennials are hardy, and can be left in the ground over winter, whilst others may need some protection (e.g. Pelargoniums). The above ground growth usually dies down in winter, but a few perennials are also evergreen (e.g. elephants ears (*Bergenia*).

Many herbaceous plants benefit from being divided about every two to three years. This improves growth, vigour and flowering. Division can be carried out at any time of year, but is generally best done in late autumn or early spring. Depending on prevailing weather conditions, March is usually a good time to divide perennials, as the soil should be starting to warm up, encouraging plant growth.

Old plants should be carefully dug up, and the best method to divide them will depend on the structure of their root system.

Plants with fibrous roots can be pulled apart into several portions, each one retaining a number of roots and growth buds. Old tough clumps can be levered apart using the traditional (and satisfying!) way of two garden forks back to back. Plant only the healthy portions around the outside, and discard the woody centres.

Plants with woody crowns such as delphiniums, should be washed to reveal the growth buds, and then using a sharp knife, the crown cut into portions, each retaining a good bud and roots.

Some plants have underground stems called rhizomes, and portions, from the outside each about 6 cm long, can be cut off and replanted. Again, the old centres can be thrown away.

Tuberous plants, such as Dahlia, can be propagated, by cutting the tuber into vertical sections, so that each piece contains a portion of the stem and a strong growth bud.

Divisions should be replanted as soon as possible, at the same depth as the parent, with sufficient space and ensuring the roots don't dry out while they reestablish.

#### Dear All

This year Holy Week falls right at the end of March and into April, with Easter on the 5<sup>th</sup> April. Mothering Sunday is on the 15<sup>th</sup> March, with a short communion service at Uffington at 10.30am, when we'll bless bunches of flowers for the children to give out, then Palm Sunday is on the 29<sup>th</sup> March - why not come along to Greatford for a special group service, when we'll have the blessing of the palms and a dramatised reading of the Passion story as part of the communion service.

There's plenty going on in Holy Week across the group, too, with at least one service every day, so that you can follow the story right the way through the week and walk the way of the cross. On Monday and Tuesday evenings there will be communion services at 7pm - Monday at Uffington, Tuesday at Greatford - and on Wednesday there will be a communion service at 10am at West Deeping. On Thursday evening there will be a commemoration of the Last Supper starting in Braceborough village hall and moving on to the church - see the separate notice for details. This is a great opportunity for fellowship as well as a chance to learn about the first Holy Week, and well worth coming to.

Good Friday is going to follow the same pattern as the last few years. The church services will take place as usual, in West Deeping at IIam and Uffington at 2pm, and once again some of us will be walking (on footpaths, not the road) from one church to the other, with a pause in Tallington on the way. You can come to just the services, just the walk, or join us for part of the route - check the posters at each church for exact timings, and let's hope that the weather stays fine... There'll also be our usual evening service at Barholm at 7pm.

Easter Day will be full of services - not only will there be a communion service in each church (full details in the April magazine), but we're going to start the day with an Easter Vigil and the lighting of the new fire, otherwise known as a dawn service. The good news this year is that the service is later than usual — not until 6am... That's when we'll gather in the dark to read Bible stories by torchlight, as we wait to celebrate the discovery made at break of day, when the women went to the tomb and found that Christ had risen. As a sign of the light of the risen Christ coming into the world, we'll light first one and then another six Easter candles, and take them on to the parishes for the communion services later in the day. Why not stagger out of bed and really know you're celebrating Easter - and don't forget to bring bells/jangling keys/anything else that makes a joyful noise, for use during the service.

Please come and join in on Easter Day and during the preparation for it, as we experience the richness of the Christian story and celebrate the new life God gives us in Christ.

### The Last Supper

#### 7 pm, Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> April,

#### in Braceborough Village Hall

#### Tickets £2, family ticket £5, to cover a light supper

This year we're going to share a meal and service following the pattern of the early Christian church, the first followers of Christ.

When Jesus met with his friends in the first Holy Week they shared a meal and fellowship, eating and chatting, before the meal became special and significant in a new way, as Jesus blessed the bread and the wine and gave it to his disciples. We will do the same thing, sitting at table together and sharing a simple meal of bread, cheese and fruit and a glass of wine before hearing the story of that Last Supper and moving on to a celebration of communion, still seated at table.

We will also re-enact some of the other events of that evening. Just as Jesus washed the feet of his disciples (shocking them, because they thought he was too important to do that for them), so the tradition is that the most senior clergy wash the feet of at least some of those present at the service - in a cathedral, it would be the bishop or the dean. Here it will be the Rector (NB having your feet washed is not compulsory - volunteers only!). And at the end of the evening, as Jesus and the disciples went to the Garden of Gethsemane to pray, we move on to the church, where traditional psalms will be read and the altar stripped, ready for the bleakness of Good Friday.

If you'd like to find out more about the Last Supper, and how communion as we know it started, why not come along and find out. This celebration is open to everyone, whether they've been confirmed or not, and is a family occasion where children are welcome (it will go on until at least 8.30pm, but families can opt out of the time in church). Tickets are available from the churchwardens or the Rector - please do book, so that we know how many we are catering for. Also, please note that this is a *light* supper – you'll need to eat beforehand.

#### BRACEBOROUGH & WILSTHORPE PARISH COUNCIL

Concern was again expressed at the February Parish Council meeting about damage to verges and pot holes not being repaired. Ring 01522 782070 during office hours or the Police for highways emergency (out of office hours), for non-emergencies go to the Lincolnshire County Council website www.lincolnshire.gov.uk/highwaysdefects or email LLCHighwaysWest@lincolnshire.gov.uk

The proposed closure of the Greatford/Banthorpe railway crossing was also discussed. This proposition would divide the parish of Braceborough with residents of Banthorpe, having to use the Essendine road to travel to Greatford for voting purposes. It was suggested that an underpass be constructed under the crossing which would benefit the majority, if you would like to comment visit Network Rails website (by 2<sup>nd</sup> March) at www.networkrail.co.uk/ECMLlevelcrossings.

The following planning applications were discussed:- 12 Main Street, Braceborough-first floor extension – no objection, Holland House, Wilsthorpe-erection of 1.8m wooden fence – objection as design out of character of the village, highways safety, visually intrusive, and contrary to SKDC Core Strategy. lvy Lodge, Braceborough-demolition of existing lean-to storage shed etc was approved by SKDC.

Cllr. Kentish reported that he hoped to have the Parish Plan booklet completed by middle March ready for distribution.

Correspondence had been received from Anglian Water as follows:- Late February new access road adjacent to Windy Corner will be cleared of all vegetation. Early May will be contacting householders individually to confirm their connection intentions, Early May construction will start on the access road area leading towards the pumping station in the field at the rear of Windy Corner – Main Street will be closed at this location from Monday  $4^{\rm th}$  May to Friday  $8^{\rm th}$  May. Late June road closures will start within the village for the construction of the new sewers. Late September will have completed construction of the sewers and the roads will be re-opened to traffic.

C.Cllr Martin Trollope-Bellew reported that Ofsted had rated Children's Services -5 Good and 1 Excellent. LCC portion of the County Tax would be increased by 1.9%, with the Police increasing by 1.95%. The County suggests that they decrease the number of councillors from 77 to 71 in the new boundary review. The combined Fire/Ambulance Station at Stamford is operational. Residents Parking in Stamford has commenced, look out for new parking restrictions.

D.Cllr Channell reported that she had arranged a briefing at Carlby Village Hall to discuss the Local Plan.

The next Parish Council meeting will take place on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2015 at 7.30pm at Braceborough & Wilsthorpe Village Hall. All Welcome.

Church Flowers - None during Lent

**Uffington WI.** The life and times of John Clare, Northamptonshire's Victorian rural poet, who lived not far away at Helpston, was the subject of David Dykes' talk to Uffington WI when it held its first meeting of 2015 on February 4<sup>th</sup>. An original mind with an entirely fresh approach to poetry. Clare rose from country obscurity to become lionised by the chattering classes when he published his first collection. Poems Descriptive of Rural Life and Scenery', by the young man who had left his village school at aged just 13, outsold the work of Keats when it appeared in 1820. But Clare had had his brief moment in the sun and his later three collections never achieved the same literary success. He fell into depression, and his black moods and lack of self-esteem led to problems which eventually brought him into asylum care. Nevertheless, he left a legacy of more than 3,500 poems which ring as true to the country-dweller today as they did in the 1800s, and modern environmentalists revere him as one who championed the natural world. 'Clare's tragedy,' observed David Dykes, 'was that he never fitted in with the upper classes, and neither with the class that he came from.' Mr Dykes, manager at Clare Cottage, Helpston, was thanked for his talk by Sarah Pattinson. At the business meeting which followed, members were told that plans for the branch's 70<sup>th</sup> birthday dinner in March were having to be swiftly reorganised following the unexpected closure of the chosen venue. Menus for the revised evening will be circulated before the event. Members were reminded that tickets were available for the Bourne and District Home Economics Group Spring Meeting at Bourne Corn Exchange on March 30<sup>th</sup>. Entertainment will be 'Flanders and Swann Recaptured'. 



Kelham & I have been actively involved in visiting residents of Tallington, who live along the Barholm Road, to see what support there is for the proposed development of 200 houses to help pay for a by-pass when the level crossing is closed.

The District Council will be discussing whether to increase or freeze the Council Tax at its meeting on the 2<sup>nd</sup> March. The result from its consultation was that 51% wanted SKDC to freeze its element of the tax while 49% thought it should be increased by 2%. It is hoped that Councillors will agree to it being frozen for another year without compromising front line services.

Parish Councils have had the opportunity to engage with Officers from SKDC by attending briefing sessions to give their views on the forth coming Local Plan. The Plan will give the Districts vision on future development over the next 20 years.
