



WILDLIFE & GARDENING IN JANUARY

Happy New Year! We wonder if you have been garden planning for the year ahead? Do you have a wall, tree, fence, pergola, arch or other such structure, and wish to cover it with attractive greenery and flowers? Well now would be a suitable time to plant a climbing or rambling rose. Choose a bare root specimen, as these tend to be cheaper than container grown plants. Follow the planting instructions, usually supplied with your rose, and get them in the ground as soon as possible.

These two types of rose are somewhat different beasts – ramblers tend to flower just once in the season, and are generally very vigorous. Popular varieties include 'Rambling Rector' and 'Kiftsgate'. They can be good for growing into tall trees. Climbing roses usually repeat flower, and are generally better behaved in growth than their rambling cousins. To name just one – 'Madame Alfred Carriere' is a good variety. When choosing a suitable rose for your garden, calculate the maximum height of your structure. If you plant a hugely vigorous rambling rose up an arch for example, you will be forever pruning, trying to keep it within bounds. If you only have a relatively low fence or wall, you can plant something like an English Rose, from David Austin, which are essentially bush roses, but with little formative pruning will grow as low climbers (e.g. 6-8 feet tall).

Both types of rose are great for wildlife. They give good structure, provide valuable bird nesting sites, and the hips are a good food source for birds and small mammals etc. In general the best roses for bees, are those possessing single petals, similar to their wild-rose cousins. These allow insects to get into the flower to obtain nectar and pollen. The climber 'Altissimo', which has large single red flowers, is a good example. However many of the multi-flowered varieties are also okay, so long as the petals don't bunch too tightly, thereby covering the flower centre. The variety 'Madame Isaac Pereire' is an example of this. Although it has bunched petals, you can still see the yellow centre of the flower, and it is a magnet for bumblebees. Some rose growers websites (such as Peter Beale's) will helpfully tell you if a rose variety is valuable for bees and other wildlife.

I hope you've all enjoyed your Christmas, and that you're all set for the fresh start of a New Year.

I've mentioned blessing a wedding ring when the original has been lost - the marriage itself can be blessed, too. That could be a renewal of vows for a silver, ruby or golden wedding, a re-dedication after a rough patch, or a blessing for a couple who didn't get married in church but would like a religious ceremony now - whether they've been married a few days or weeks or for years. And did you know there are services celebrating the gift of a child, which can be used if you're not sure about baptism, but also if you've adopted a child and would like an official celebration, or if the baptism was held elsewhere and you'd like a celebration here, too.

There's a variety of services, too, for people who are ill. Anyone unable to get to church can always have communion brought to them at home, of course, but there are also special prayers and anointing for healing, to be used with or without communion, and services for particular occasions - like the one for someone too ill or frail to get to a funeral. And then there are the one-offs to mark all sorts of special occasions - retirement, engagement, the starting of a new group or the closing down of an old one, sending someone off on a special journey. The possibilities are endless.

Most of those services could take place in church - but none of them has to. I've renewed marriage vows at a silver wedding party, taken services in homes and halls, and blessed things all over the place. Whether you're celebrating or in more sombre mood, why not let the church help you mark the occasion - we're here to help.

BRACEBOROUGH & WILSTHORPE PARISH COUNCIL

Wishing everybody a peaceful, happy and healthy New Year.

A Parish Council Meeting was held on 8^{TH} December 2014 at Braceborough & Wilsthorpe Village Hall.

The ownership of dykes was discussed during the Public Forum. The Chairman suggested that for clarification residents should check with the local drainage authority and speak to the landowner on the open side of the ditch. Cllr Kentish apologized for not consulting with property owners.

The clerk informed the Councillors that 19 sites have been approved to place passive speed signs within both villages. Pot holes at Wilsthorpe had not been dealt with.

It was proposed that the 2015/16 precept be increased from £2442 to £2490. The request from St Faith's Church PCC for a grant towards the maintenance of the Churchyard was agreed for payment during the next financial year. No other requests had been received.

It was decided that no objections be made in regards to planning application to the demolition of the lean-to storage shed & erection of single storey extension at lvy Lodge, Braceborough.

It was agreed not to proceed with the offer of 100 sandbags & sand. It was reported that LCC Contractors had not repaired the verge alongside The Elms, Quincey's Lane & the drainage & gulley on Church Lane. Fly tipping was again a problem on the Carlby Road towards Greatford. It was reported that the Anglianwater Contractors left Wilsthorpe Road in a mess after felling the trees in the spinney where the pumping station will be situated. It is hoped that the Parish Plan will be ready to go to the printers in the New Year.

D.Cllr Channell gave a report on the survey conducted at the site of the new pumping station at Wilsthorpe. C.Cllr Trollope-Bellew reported that Network Rail would be giving an update on proposed closure of crossings at Tallington, Casewick footpath & Greatford/Banthorpe in January. Lincolnshire Police had requested extra funding to be able to balance the books.

The next Parish Council meeting will take place on Monday 2^{nd} February 2015 at 7.30pm at Braceborough & Wilsthorpe Village Hall. All Welcome.

Report from Parish Council Meeting held on 19th Nov 2014 at 8pm in the Village Hall

Tallington By Pass – Network Rail to report at a further meeting held on 20th November, **Reactive Speed Signs** – A speed sign has been purchased by the Parish Council at a cost of £2270.40 plus VAT. Three positions have been agreed by the Lincolnshire Road Safety Partnership one at each end of the Al175 and one on the Greatford Road. Once the camera has arrived it will be put at one of these sites and will be changed around periodically. Should anyone wish to contribute to this they are very welcome a sum of up to £20 was agreed at the meeting. Pedestrian Crossing at top of Casewick Lane on A1175 – C.Cllr. M. Trollope-Bellew suggested that if Tallington get a bridge or bypass the Parish Council should apply for a crossing under a 106 Agreement due to the envisaged increase in traffic.

7 Main Road. SKDC planning has advised the occupants of this property that retrospective planning permission is required for the shed and decking that has been erected in their garden.

Highway Matters – This is an ongoing problem but the Parish Council will keep trying to get our complaints dealt with ASAP.

Dist. Cllr. Woolley stated that SKDC were providing a ton of sand and 100 free sand bags for communities at risk of flooding. She also reported that the NALC had published an amendment to standing orders for Parish Councils. Details of this are in the Minutes on the Uffington Parish Web site or by contacting the Clerk.

C. Cllr. Reported that the Lincs Police Force would have to save during 2015/16 - 7 Million and 2016/17 - 11 million.

He also reported that it takes 1.8 million to run the Lincs. Air Ambulance which relies on donations and have around 1000 calls outs per year.

He also stated that parking permits would be available in Stamford in the New Year.

Mrs. B. Smith who writes up the minutes wrote to say that after 15 years she would have to retire. It was agreed to give her a leaving present and a copy of the new Uffington Book written by Mr. Nick Sheehan was suggested. The Clerk to thank her for her contribution to the village and Parish Council.


